DOING THINGS THE WRONG WAY

Text: Exodus 2:11-22

Introduction

The Scriptures are mostly silent on the early years of Moses. This passage gives us some insight on what happens when we set out to do the right things the wrong way. Notice what happened in the Life of Moses after he killed the Egyptian.

I. Authority was Canceled

He acted on his own and in doing so He lost all authority that he had.

II. Integrity Compromised

Because he had no authority to act, Moses now becomes a Murderer

III. Energy is Consumed v.12

Like Moses how much energy is wasted trying to correct things we never should have done

IV. Influence is Conceded vs. 13, 14

Because of his sin, he was not able to act as a mediator between his brethren

V. Identity is Confused v.19

Moses was not an Egyptian, but that is what he was viewed as. So if we do not act like a Christian we should not expect to be viewed as one

VI. Duty is Changed vs. 21,22

Before God could use him the way he wanted to, He had to teach Moses some lessons about humility.

We should always strive to do right things the right way.
